MARRIAGE MOMENTS

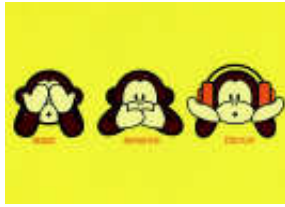

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Holy Cross Cemetery rules and regulations have been revised and are more restrictive in terms of landscaping and permanent plantings. The revisions are intended to preserve the sacred dignity of the cemetery and to ensure a safe environment for visitors and maintenance personnel. While the changes may appear unnecessary to some, they are consistent with the rules and regulations established in 1972, yet they are not as restrictive as the diocese' cemeteries and other public cemeteries.

The Cemetery Committee will begin enforcing the new regulations this spring. Families are encouraged to review the regulations and take appropriate action relative to their loved one's graves.
