I thank everyone who participated in our Open House on Sunday, January 29. We enjoyed showcasing our classrooms and our curriculum to prospective students and their families. Our administration, faculty and staff did a super job in all of their preparations. Remember we are now taking applications for the 2012-2013 school year and we would love to have your student join Holy Cross School.

Our Daily Lottery Raffle for 2011-2012 continues to attract winners. As of January 14, the Daily Lottery Raffle has paid out \$11,995 on a potential payout of \$19,410. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Holy Cross Cemetery rules and regulations have been revised and are more restrictive in terms of landscaping and permanent plantings. The revisions are intended to

preserve the sacred dignity of the cemetery and to ensure a safe environment for visitors and maintenance personnel. While the changes may appear unnecessary to some, they are consistent with the rules and regulations established in 1972, yet they are not as restrictive as the diocese' cemeteries and other public cemeteries.

The Cemetery Committee will begin enforcing the new regulations this spring. Families are encouraged to review the regulations and take appropriate action relative to their loved one's graves.
